THE KLINIKUM AUGSBURG

Since 1st January 2000, the Clinics and Institutes of the Klinikum, the Clinic for Children and Juveniles and the "Klinikum Augsburg Sued" (until 31.12.2005 the hospital of Haunstetten) have been managed under the legal form of an independent joint undertaking (KU). The funding agent is the "Krankenhauszweckverband" Augsburg, which is in turn funded by the City of Augsburg and the Rural District of Augsburg.

As well as the Klinikum, this joint undertaking also runs the Clinic for Children and Juveniles (total number 1573 beds) and the Klinikum Augsburg Sued with 168 beds. The Klinikum, together with the Clinic for Children and Juveniles and the Klinikum Augsburg Sued, is a hospital in the highest health care category for the City of Augsburg (population approx. 270,000), the Rural District of Augsburg (pop. approx. 240,000) and for the whole of the Regional Authority of Swabia (pop. approx. 1.8 million).

The Klinikum Augsburg comprises a total of 24 clinics and institutes. The treatment facilities, departments and institutes cover the complete field of all medical specialities. There are the following clinics and institutes:
